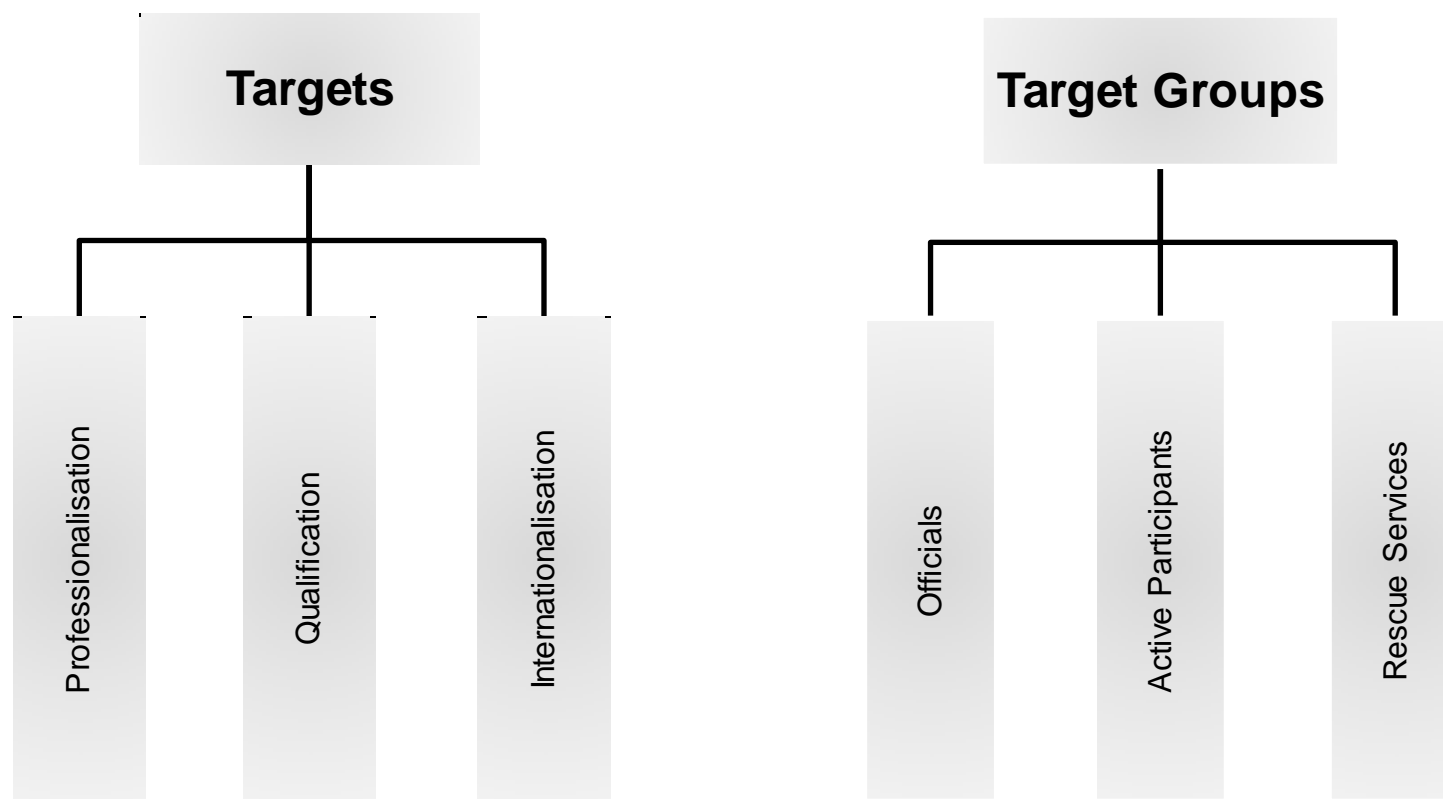

Targets and Target Groups



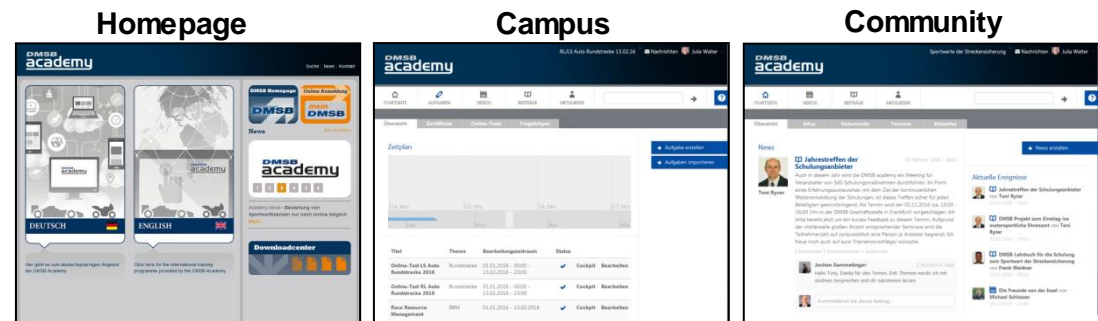
Professionalisation of the Framework Conditions

Optimisation of the framework conditions

- Updating of the training and examination regulations as well as of the discipline-related training guidelines
- Upgrading of the system of grades of officials' licences and of the licensing procedures, e.g. by issuing a three years valid licence upon successful participation in an education and/or training seminar
- Evaluation and marketing of the existing data

Current media services offered

- Independent internet presence at www.dmsb-academy.de
- Seminar administration and online-registration at mein.DMSB.de
- Establishment of a Blended Learning Platform as learning platform (campus) and as exchange platform (community)



Qualification of those Involved

Establishment of a “Train-the-Trainer“ programme

- DMSB Certificate for Lecturers (15 units) and DOSB Certification for Instructors (30 units) in the modules “Personal and Social Skills” and “Methodical Competence”
- Symposia and workshops for selected target groups

Establishment of a monitoring programme for local seminars

Cooperation with university institutions, e.g.

- Recognition of trainee appointments for the internship and of Academy seminars as ECTS (Credit Points)
- Preparation of student research projects with reference to motorsport
- Common network for lecturer, educational and learning materials

Central coordination of talent scouting (“young volunteers”), e.g. as member of a body, official, coach or volunteer

Further development of the support of candidates, e.g.

- Recruitment, promotion and support of highly qualified candidates
- Installation of a candidate pool in all areas and central coordination of the trainee appointments

- FIA-approved Regional Training Provider (since 09.07.2013)
- FIA-approved Medical Regional Training Provider (since 20.11.2014)



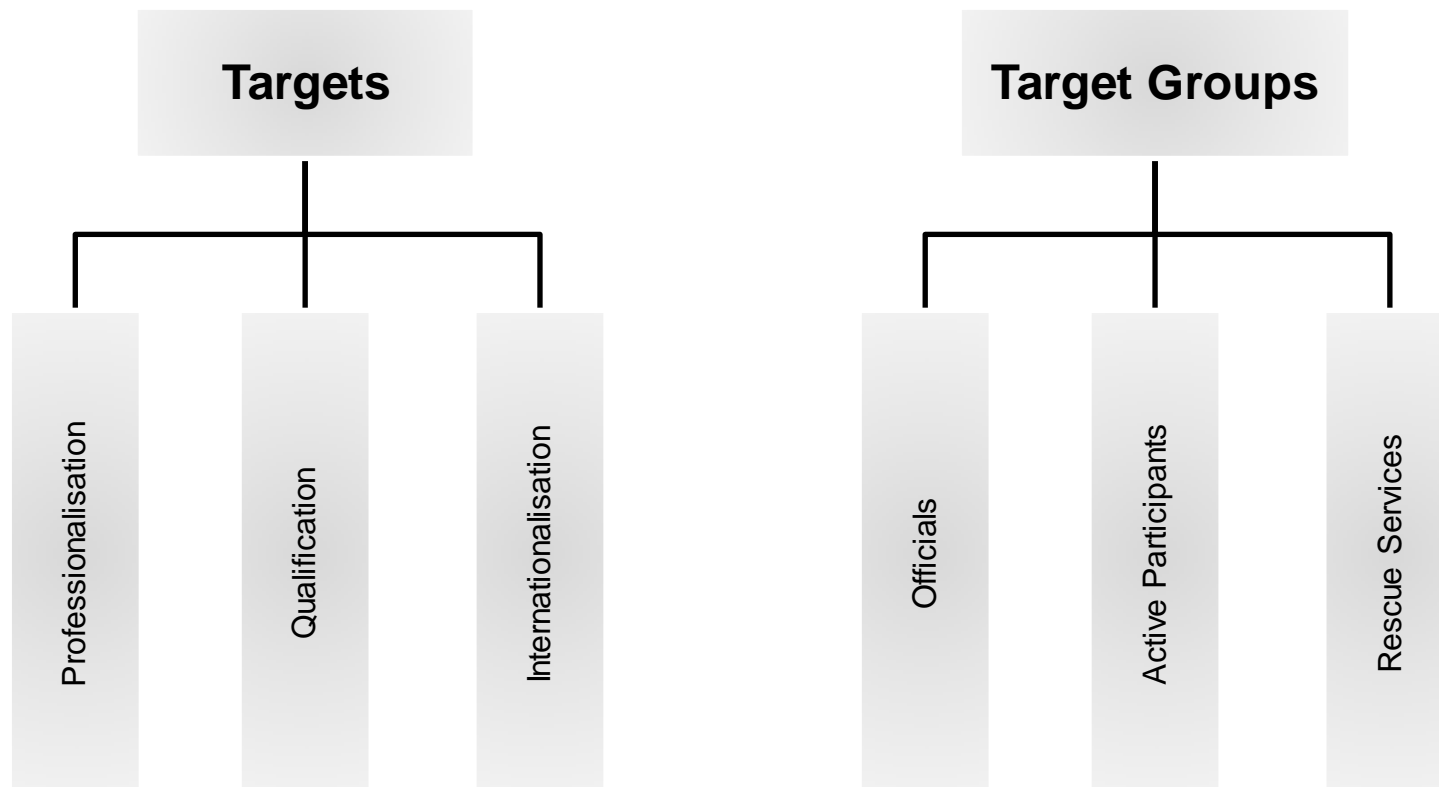
Preparation of multilingual teaching and learning materials

Enhancement of the range of services e.g.

- Coordination and organisation of seminars in English and opening to participants of other ASNs/FMNs
- Organisation of international seminars on behalf of the FIA, e.g. „Extrication Days“ for the certification of Extrication Teams of other ASNs
- Organisation of international seminars on behalf of the FIM & FIM Europe

Further development of all educational and training activities of the DMSB in accordance with international examples, e.g. the example of the FIA Institute (Best Practice Framework)

Learning Opportunities for Officials

Training of all officials in central seminars

- Training of DMSB officials in automobile and motorcycle sports
- Training of the officials of the DMSB-Staffel
- Training of additional target groups, e.g. media officers, environmental officers

Further development of all educational and training activities for officials, e.g.

- Greater relevance to practical application, e.g. by the involvement of active drivers and senior official as well as integration of race tracks, of TÜV and DEKRA (Technical Inspection Associations) as well as of other DMSB partners
- Preparation of modular teaching and learning materials (e.g. training films, MC tests, webinars)
- Nationwide use of the blended learning platform

Enhancement of the range of services, e.g.

- „Race Resource Management“ (RRM) to train human skills and behaviour in order to prevent accident occurring.



Learning Opportunities for Active Participants

Training for all instructors with DMSB licences

Cooperation with car manufacturers e.g. within the framework of driving courses

Further development of all educational and training activities targeted to active participants (e.g. drivers, competitors, instructors), e.g.

- E-Learning for DPN licence holders
- E-Learning for training providers
- Specialised trainings, e.g. rights and duties of drivers/competitors

Enhancement of the range of services, e.g. in form of driving courses in cooperation with the training providers to obtain a licence

- Organisation of driving courses for Medical Car Drivers
- Organisation of driving courses for Safety Car Drivers
- Organisation of driving courses for all drivers of the mobile track safety units (e.g. DMSB-Staffel, ambulances)

Learning Opportunities for Rescue Services

Training of the complete medical staff during the „Medical Services Education & Training Days“

Further development of all educational and training activities in the fields of medical services, e.g.

- Medical Car
- Medical Intervention Car
- Extrication
- Realistic accident scenarios

Enhancement of the range of services, e.g.

- „Race Track Trauma Life Support“ (RTTLS) as concept for the structured and priority-oriented medical care of seriously injured patients during motor sport events.
